With the disruption in global supply chain caused by COVID-19, it is more urgent than ever for product and manufacturing enterprises to start their digital transformation journey by digitizing designs and producing parts on-demand with Additive Manufacturing (AM).

One of the key challenges enterprises face is identifying and selecting the right parts to be printed. In addition, ensuring that the part design is re-optimized so that it can be 3D printed cost effectively with consistent quality is a huge undertaking. These processes pose a challenge to many companies due to a

challenges, Enterprise Singapore and NAMIC are jointly launching an **Open Grant Call for Parts Analysis and Design for AM** programme – which includes an *end-to-end* AM technology demonstration and feasibility assessment including part selection, design optimization, fabrication as well as testing. The programme is divided into 2 phases:

Phase 1 – Part identification and analysis supported by NAMIC Tech Hubs.

Phase 2 – Part fabrication and test study where the lead applicant (i.e. end-user/product owner/contract manufacturer) will work with Singapore-based AM service providers. The qualifiable costs of the project are supportable under the Enterprise Development Grant (EDG).

Application period: 1 June 2021 to 30 June 2022
